The internal job link posting off of the graphic-design site has been removed and replaced with a link to career services at Fanshawe college.

Once you have logged into Fanshaweonline, you will see a career services link at the bottom-right. This will take you to the Fanshawe job portal.

You may need your student card number to log in.

The reasons I have shifted the organization and posting of jobs to this service are:

Career services facilitate the verifications of these jobs

More and more non-fanshawe students were using our job board to apply for jobs. This was coming back to me from prospective employers as a negative. They were being inundated with applications, most of which weren't from one of us

Many employers are looking for cheap or free labour, using the Fanshawe service alleviates the vetting of the authenticity of employers by me and puts it into the hands of a dedicated career services employee.

Employers can use this service to log in and post jobs using an automated system

This system is much more organized, diverse and up to date then what was previously offered off of our site.
